Mr Tubs and Tiles Care Plan

Restored surfaces:

To get the best life and use out of your newly restored area clean only with a soft cloth and soft liquid soap. Dry surface with a soft cloth when not in use.

Do not touch or use for 48 hours after completion. Do not wipe area for 10 days after completion. Do not use bath mats. Do not wipe with abrasive utensils, steel wool, scourers, abrasive powders, pastes, dry cleaning fluids, thinners, window cleaning sprays, bleaches, caustic soda, products with high ammonia content like toilet cleaners.

Do not use resurfaced area as a wash trough or clothes bin. Do not leave unattended dripping or running taps that are dripping onto the resurfaced area.

Do not leave bottles, shampoos, soaps etc on the resurface area as this can cause discolouration or staining.

Do not try picking off any dust or foreign particle stuck on the resurface area after installation. Wait 10 days and then gently wipe away with a soft liquid soap and a soft cloth.

Please follow the above care instructions to keep the warranty intact.

Rigid Interlocking Floor Tiles:

Your newly tiled area is ready for use immediately but don't touch the silicone for 24 hours.

To get the best life and use out of your newly tiled area please follow the following care plan.

Maintain the floor by sweeping, vacuuming or mopping. Use a soft bristled brush and a phneutral detergent to remove stubborn dirt. Any staining or aggressive substances must be remove right away. Use of mats is a good idea to reduce the dirt.

Castors and sliders suitable for hardwood floors need to be used for furniture or mobile furniture.

Dyed rubber-based wheels and castors eg bicycle tyres, pneumatic tyres etc may cause irreversible colour changes if coming into contact with the tiles.
